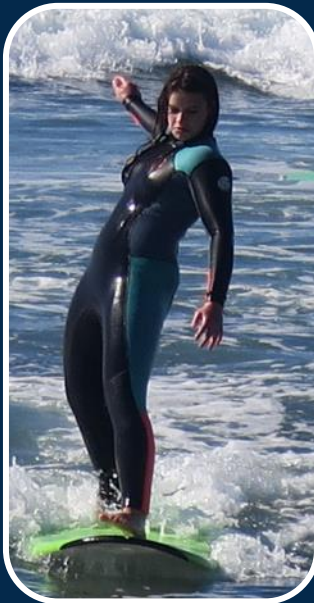

## How much will this trip cost?

### Approximate Cost—\$1850.00 U.S. Dollars (Final price will be set by May 1st)

A deposit of \$925 USD will be charged to your credit card as soon as you are registered. If you register prior to July 1<sup>st</sup> your card will not be charged until July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020. Registration deadline is September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2020. The balance of \$925 USD will be charged to your credit card October 10<sup>th</sup>, 2020

## What's Included

The price includes the following;

- Air transportation round trip from Seattle for US students and Victoria for Canadian Students
- Ground transportation while in California
- Hotel accommodations at the Desert Palms Hotel (4 students per room)
- Three-day pass to Disneyland/ California Adventure.
- Admission to Universal Studios
- Admission to Knott's Berry Farm Theme Park
- Surfing lessons at Huntington Beach
- Meals included
  - Daily breakfast in the hotel (Thursday-Monday)
  - Daily lunch (Thursday-Sunday)
  - Dinner Saturday
