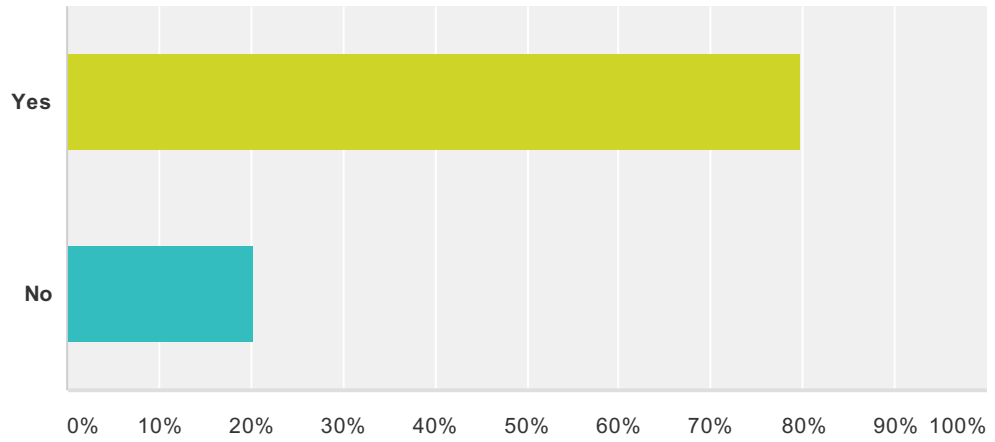


Q1 Are you currently an OAPSA member?

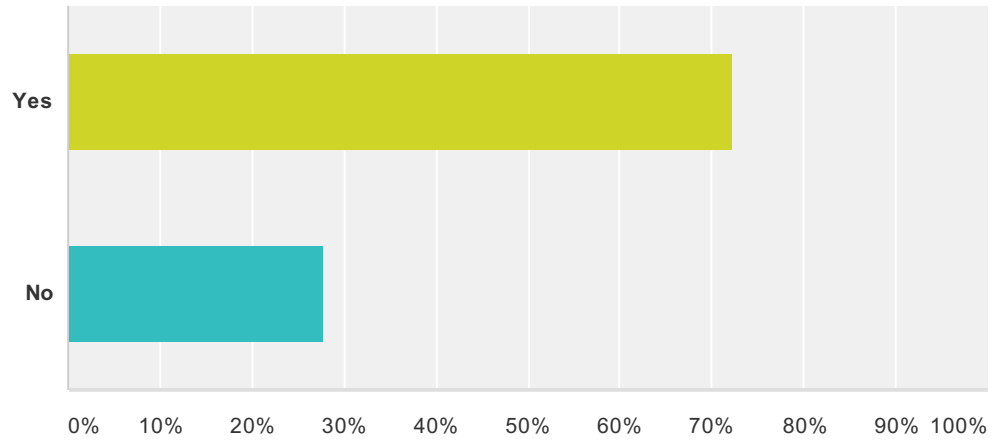

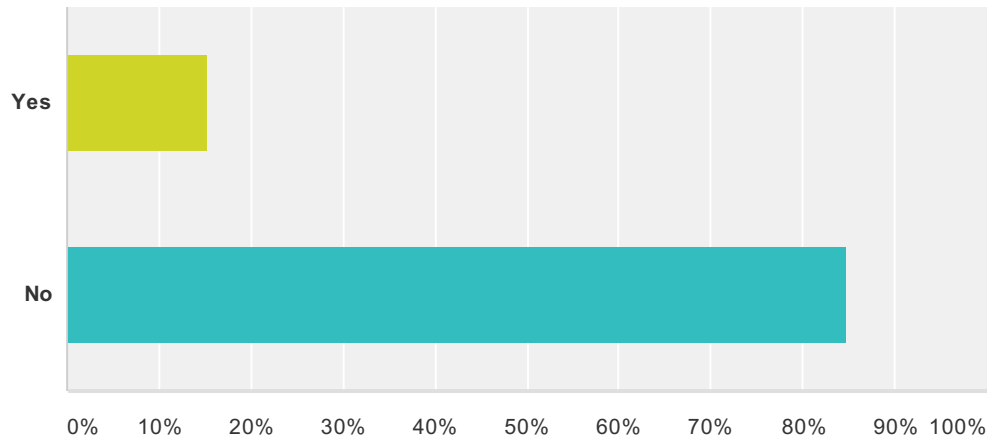

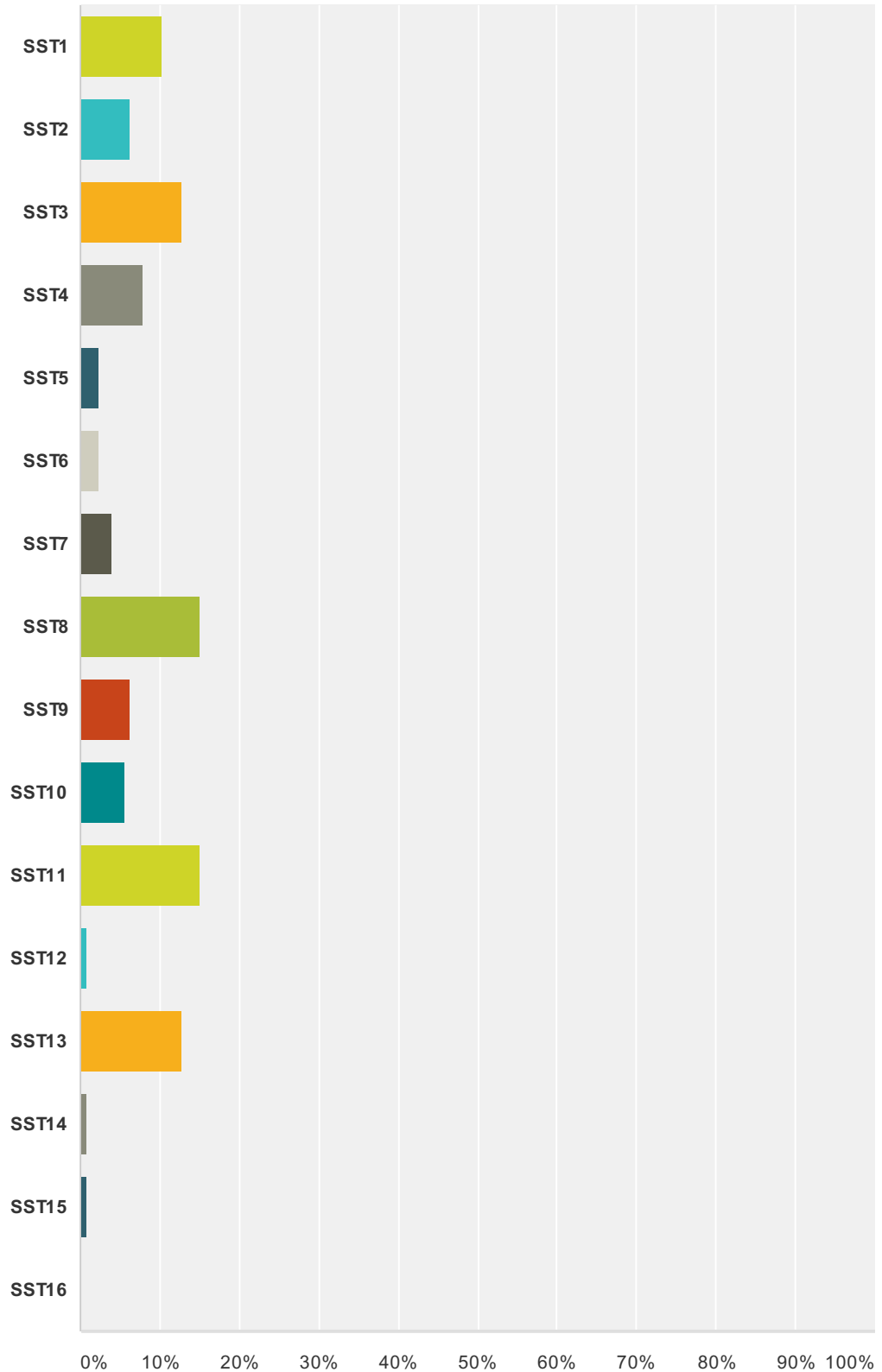

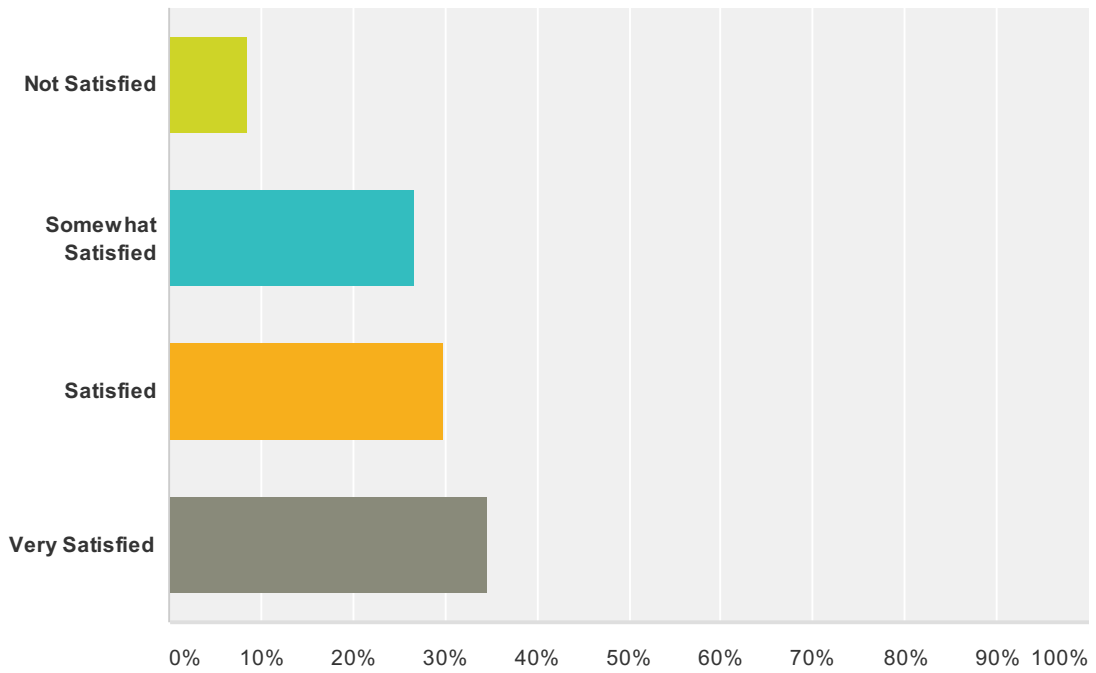
