This hotel outreach program launched in this area in January. There only other source of support has been with their church. They have worked with other hotel outreaches in Dallas and other areas to share information and get started. Often times kids between Dallas and Austin end up in Killeen at some point.

Originally they started with the posters but were only able to showcase 10 profiles. While some of these are good in a public type display they have found the brochures to be more useful. They can put 20 missing children on there along with education information like red flags and what to do if a child is sighted.

Our funds if approved means they will get to expand to the gas stations along with the hotels and motels. \$1200 gets the 20 child profiles out to the public via brochures for a whole year.

As far as the deadline for payment. She just tallied monthly what a year would look like. Each month new brochures get printed because some of the children are recovered. Each monthly she coordinates with the center is missing and exploited children data base for missing children that are from Dallas down to Austin. Then they work with their law enforcement contacts to see if the children are still missing. Following that they will print the brochures.

So this would not be a reimbursement it will start a new set brochures with 20 kids and help them expand their locations.
