The docks went in without too many issues. The worker turnout was light, but the guys that showed up were hard workers and continued to work after lunch. We have a few extra slips if anyone wants a second dock or knows someone that wants to join the club.

There still remain a few things that need to be done:

- The docks need to be power washed.
- Eleven pipe brackets need to be bolted onto the docks.
- A ladder needs to be installed onto the dry docks
- The spacer planks between Sunfish sections need to be lag screwed
- A steel cable needs to be strung thru dock sections

Building Update

Many have asked for an update on our building progress. Things have been changing on almost a weekly basis, so please keep that in mind. I fully expect most of the below information to change.

Currently, we are proposing two low profile buildings on each side of Water St. They are low profile so as not to block our neighbors' view of the river. The building on the river side would contain a meeting area, kitchen & restrooms. The building on the downtown side would have an office, guest shower & restroom, member lockers and storage. The building on the river side would be level with Water St on concrete pillars 15 feet above the bulkhead. It will have lots of glass overlooking the water and a deck.

Thus far, we have only been successful with obtaining two of the six needed zoning variances. Several professionals have been hired to assist us with this project.

1:00 hands on instruction in: (A), (B), (C)
- 7-13 8:30 to 9:30** maps and navigation, knot tying
9:30 travel to tour the National Great Lakes Museum and the Freighter (opens at 10:00am) Schoonmaker (admission fee included in registration) LUNCH, bring a sack lunch. We will need drivers and adults to accompany the group.
1:00 to 4:30+/- Tour the USCG facility (on N. Summit Street) and boats and learn about USCG missions.
5:00 to 6:30 basic first aid
6:00-? Class & Club Pot Luck. Club furnishes hot dogs, families bring dish to pass.
- 7-14 8:00-10:30** float the river in canoes, kayaks, rafts etc. to "storm the Fort" (will need pick up drivers)
Life jackets worn NO EXCEPTIONS, must have swim shoes or old tennis shoes to wear in boats/canoes/kayaks on float down. Bring dry socks and shoes to wear for tour.
10:45 Tour the fort (admission fee included in registration)
1:30 LUNCH at Fort Meigs (bring sack lunch to be delivered to Fort)
2:30 to 4:30 float to PBC
4:30 Boat Camp "graduation".
- 7-15 8:30- 1:30** Open for continuation of A, B, C. Ewing Island tour With Metro Park Naturalist.
LUNCH at the Club. Bring sack lunch and drink.
1:30 boat camp concludes

Pack a sack lunch with drink each day. Bring or wear swim suit, towel and lifejacket that fits.

Life Jackets must be worn when in boats or swimming in river, no exceptions! Seat belts must be worn when in cars/vehicles, no exceptions!

Registration is with the health and waiver of liability form. One per participant. It must be completed by adults responsible for youth and notarized then mailed by 7-5-16 with the \$30 per person fee. We are limited to first 27 youth registered. Open to PBC youth, guests and the public.

Discipline issues will result in youth being sent home, no refunds.
