The City of Shelton is moving forward with the Basin 3 Inflow and Infiltration (I/I) Project. This project will replace the sewer mains by both trenching and trenchless cured in place pipe, from Northcliff Rd. south to Cedar St. and from N Front St. west to 9th St. (please see attached project location map). The purpose of the project is to prevent ground and surface water from entering the sewer mains and laterals and causing harm to the City's sewer system or to private businesses and homes. With the replacement of the sewer mains, the project is also mandated to install new service laterals again by both trenching and trenchless cured in place pipe from the mains, to within two (2) feet of the existing structure.

Attached is a Temporary Permit to enter your property for construction of the service lateral for the duration of the project (2017 to 2019). Both systems of installation may require the City's Contractor to access the property for trenching, receiving pits, and installation of a service lateral backflow prevention device. In addition, plumbing changes to the existing structure may have to be made in order to connect to the new service lateral. You will be notified prior to any of this work being performed. Any costs for these plumbing changes will be paid for by the Basin 3 project and any areas disturbed during construction on private property will be repaired to as good or better condition. If the City determines it would be infeasible or impossible to replace improvements in kind, the City shall negotiate with the Property Owner for a mutually agreeable replacement.

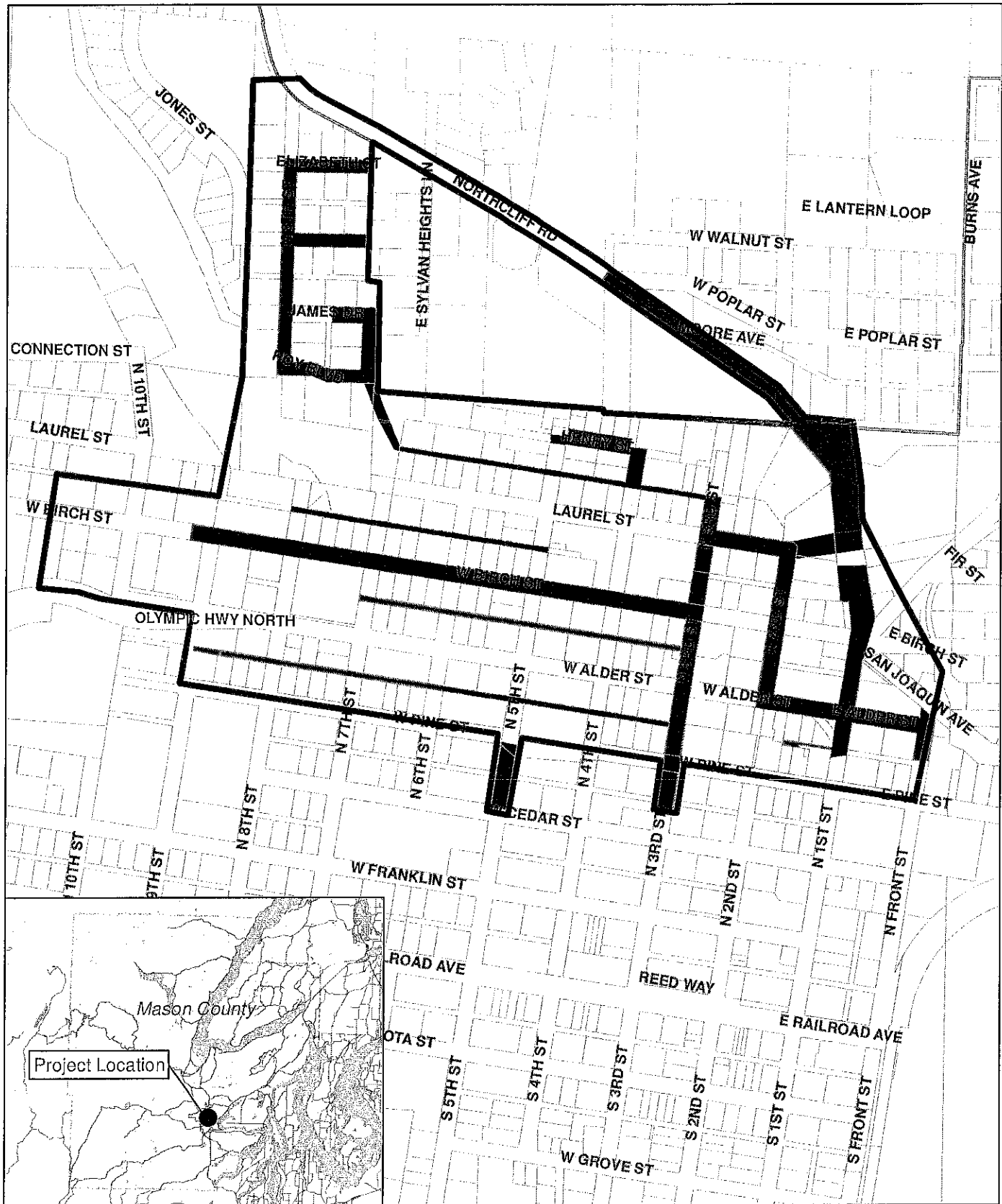

If you are a renter, please assist us by providing any contact information for the property owner or rental agency you rent from on the back of the permit so that we may obtain a Temporary Permit to Enter from them as well.

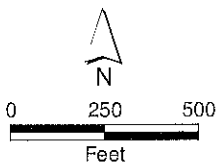
