Dave Mangs joined the West Hartford Ct. Rotary Club in 1993. In addition to serving his local club as a board member for 8 years and Club President from 2006-2007, Dave served as Youth Exchange officer, RYLA coordinator, and Ambassadorial Scholarship coordinator. Dave served his District as a Rotaract Chair, and also served as Interact Chair for over a decade expanding the number of Interact Clubs and overseeing a very successful annual District Interact Conference. He is a multiple Paul Harris.

After completing a Master's in Education at Clark University in 1972, Dave worked as a vocational counselor with the Neighborhood Youth Corps helping truants and high school drop outs complete their education and get jobs. His next position was Executive Director of an employment program in Lowell, Mass. to assist ex-offenders reintegrate into the community after prison. During and after completing a second master's degree at the University of Chicago-School of Social Service Administration, Dave worked with the Illinois Law Enforcement Commission on the implementation of the Juvenile Justice Delinquency Prevention Act by establishing 10 alternative education programs, a national demonstration project for Status Offenders, and alternatives to detention for troubled youth. Dave earned his PH.D. from the Heller School for Advance Studies in Social Welfare of Brandeis University, and his dissertation was entitled: "The Removal of Status Offense Jurisdiction From the Juvenile Court: The New Maine Juvenile Code." When one of the Rotary Peace Centers went out to bid, Dave worked with Brandeis and the Waltham Rotary Club on their application. Although the final winner was Upsala University in Sweden, the Heller School was one of five finalists out of 130 Universities and Colleges that applied.

Since 1982, Dave has worked in the financial services industry. As a Financial Advisor, he has his own firm: Mangs Financial LLC (Securities offered by LPL Financial Member FINRA/SIPC) which includes his son Adam who serves as Operations Manager. Dave has earned his CLU and ChFC designations from the American College, he is a lifetime member of the Million Dollar Roundtable, a member of the Hartford Chapter of the Estate and Business Planning Council, has served as a board member of the Hartford Chapter of FSP (Financial

Service Professionals), and various community non-profit organizations. His wife Gail is an attorney working in the Bureau of Special Education at the State Dept. of Education. They have 3 children and 2 grandchildren.
