Dennis was raised in the small town of Groveton, NH. He left there in 1964 to attend the University of NH. After his freshman year he enlisted in the US Army and was released from active duty as a Staff Sergeant in August 1969. He continued his education through the U. of Maryland while in the service. After his discharge, while working full-time he attended Northeastern, UVM, UNH, and Granite State College - where he received a BS in Business Administration in 1982. He joined Digital Equipment Corp. (DEC) in 1978 as a Software Specialist and progressed through technical support, marketing, and product management, into engineering management, becoming Group Manager of DEC's Security Products Engineering Group. He retired in 2003.

In 2006 he joined two friends in starting Moisture Mapper International, Inc. to develop software applications for the water damage remediation industry. As VP & GM he handled day- to-day operations including product development and customer support. He turned the business over to the other partners in 2010.

In May of '11 Dennis was recruited by MIT Lincoln Labs as a Program Contract Administrator. He retired a year later when that program ended. In October '12 he was hired as COO of Windmill International. He retired in October 2015, for the final time.

He joined the Hollis-Brookline Rotary Club in November 2005; served as VP in 2009- 10, President in 2010-11, and Treasurer in 2011–13. He transferred to the Rotary Club of Nashua West in 2013.

Dennis is an RLI graduate, Past Assistant Governor 2011-14, Past District Secretary 2013-14.
