**“Landscapes for the People:
George Alexander Grant, First Chief Photographer of the National Park Service”**

Ren Davis is a native of Atlanta with a B.A. in History from Emory University and a master's in Public Health from Tulane University. He served in Administration at Crawford Long Hospital and Emory Healthcare from 1976 until retirement in 2009. In 2008, he was the recipient of the Heroes in Healthcare Ethics Award from the Healthcare Ethics Consortium of Georgia.

Helen Davis is a native of Lewistown, Pennsylvania. She received a B.S. in Family and Child Development, from The Ohio State University and a master's in education from Georgia State University. She taught in the Atlanta Public Schools from 1980 – 2001, then taught children with learning disabilities at Greenfield Hebrew Academy until retiring in 2009.

Ren and Helen will present the culmination of three years of research which profiles the work of George Grant, the first staff, and later first chief photographer of the National Park Service. The book was just released to coincide with the 2016 Park Service Centennial commemoration and has been nominated for a 2015 National Outdoor Book Award.

As freelance writers and photographers, Ren and Helen Davis have co-authored six guidebooks and more than 100 magazine and newspaper articles.
