Dr. Meria Carstarphen, is superintendent of Atlanta Public Schools. She brings to Atlanta an impressive record in transformative educational leadership that has led to significant student performance gains. She leads and provides oversight to the district's 50,000 students; 6,300 employees; and 106 learning sites with a nearly \$1 billion annual budget.

Dr. Carstarphen has nearly 20 years of education and experience in diverse, major metropolitan public school districts. She was superintendent of the Austin Independent School District, superintendent of the Saint Paul Public Schools in Minnesota and held senior leadership positions with other public schools systems. She began her education career as a middle school teacher in her hometown of Selma, Ala. She also has worked with elementary-level children in Seville, Spain, and Caracas, Venezuela.

As part of her community involvement, she serves on the Woodruff Arts Center Board of Trustees, the ETS Board of Trustees, the board of the Atlanta Ballet, and on the advisory committee for the Harvard Graduate School of Education. She earned a doctorate in administration, planning and social policy, with a concentration in urban superintendency from the Harvard Graduate School of Education. She earned a bachelor of arts in political science and Spanish from Tulane University and master of education degrees from Auburn University and Harvard University. She has also studied at the University of Seville, Spain, and University of Innsbruck, Austria.

Doc is a Trustee and Executive Committee member of the United States Supreme Court Historical Society and serves as Chairman of the Mercer University Board of Trustees, the Mercer University Press and Childhood Autism Foundation. He is a co-editor of *A Life in The Law* (Advice for Young Lawyers) published by the ABA.

In his spare time, Schneider is a singer-songwriter who has released three albums, all of which are available on iTunes. He and his wife, Helen, live in Brookhaven where they raised two daughters and have four grand-children, one of whom lives with them and is a freshman at St. Pius.
