### KEVIN GREINER, President and CEO

#### Gas South

Under the leadership of President and CEO **Kevin Greiner**, Gas South has become one of the South-east's leading retail natural gas providers, serving over 290,000 residential, business and governmental customers in Georgia and Florida.

Greiner has over 15 years of experience in the energy industry, including prior management roles with Southern Company. He has served as Gas South's CEO since its formation in 2006.

Greiner's dedication to the local community has also seen him take on a number of non-profit board leadership roles. He currently serves as Chairman of the Georgia Partnership for Excellence in Education, Georgia's leading education policy and advocacy organization. He sits on the Board of Directors for the United Way of Greater Atlanta and chaired their 2012-13 Workplace Campaign, which brought in over \$77 million in community investment. In addition, he serves on the Board of Governors for the Georgia Chamber of Commerce, the Board of Directors for the Buckhead Coalition as well as the Board of Directors for the YMCA of Metro Atlanta.

Greiner holds a master's degree in business administration and a master's of science in natural resource policy from the University of Michigan. He earned his bachelor's degree from Wesleyan University.

### SENATOR SAXBY CHAMBLISS

**Saxby Chambliss** served in the US Senate for two terms and four terms in the US House of Representatives. Georgia Trend magazine, which consistently named him one of its Most Influential Georgians, called him "a highly visible and well-respected presence in Washington," and says he earned "a reputation as an affable but straight-talking lawmaker."

Chambliss was first elected to Congress to represent Georgia's 8th District in 1994. Throughout his legislative career, he has been recognized numerous times by the public and private sectors for his work on agriculture, defense, budget and national security issues. He served as a member of the Senate Armed Services Committee; the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition and Forestry; the Senate Rules Committee; and the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence, where he served as vice chairman from three years. His previous role as chairman of the House Intelligence Subcommittee on Terrorism and Homeland Security made him one of the leading congressional experts on those issues.

He has received numerous awards and honors including American Farm Bureau Distinguished Service Award, Georgia Agriculture Hall of Fame, National Guard Association's Harry S Truman Award, the organization's highest honor bestowed on civilian and military leaders who demonstrate continued contributions to national defense and security and the Georgia Trend Georgian of the Year in 2009.

He received his B.A. from the UGA and his J.D. from the University of Tennessee College of Law.
