**Kaye Lanning Minchew Kaye** served as ED of the Troup County Historical Society in LaGrange, GA from 1985 until 2015. She oversaw operations of the Troup County Archives and Legacy Museum on Main.

She received a BA from UNC—Asheville, and both an MA and Master of Library Science from UNC-Chapel Hill. She served on the Board of Curators of Georgia Historical Society from 1992 to 2004 and the editorial board from 2007 to 2012. She is recipient of the Georgia Historical Records Advisory Board Lifetime Achievement Award, 2007. She was named a Fellow by the Society of American Archivists in 2011 and by the Society of Georgia Archivists in 2009.



Her book A President in Our Midst: FDR In Georgia was published by the UGA Press in May 2016. A second book, Managing Local Government Archives which is co-authored by John Slate of the City of Dallas, Texas, was published by Rowman and Littlefield in early July, 2016. She received the Bruce Dearstyne Distinguished Service Award from the National Association of Government Archivists and Records Administrators at their annual meeting in July, 2016.
