JOHN W. GARVER, PROFESSOR Georgia Tech

"China and the Iran nuclear negotiations: convergent interests and parallel diplomacy with the US"

John Garver is Professor in the Sam Nunn School of International Affairs at the Georgia Institute of Technology.

He is the author of nine books and over 100 articles and monographs dealing with China's foreign relations. His books include: China and Iran: Ancient Partners in a Post-Imperial World, The Protracted Contest, China-Indian Rivalry in the Twentieth Century and Face Off; China, the United States, and Taiwan's Democratization, (2006, 2000, 1997), Nationalist China and U.S. Cold War Strategy in Asia, and more. He has served on the editorial boards of journals such as China Quarterly and Journal of Contemporary China, and is a member of the National Committee on U.S.-China Relations.

Dr. Garver directed a university study program in China in 1983, then went on to set up and direct the first China-based summer study program in the University System of Georgia as well as a multipolity (Japan, South Korea, Taiwan, Hong Kong, China) summer study program. He has lived in various parts of China, has traveled widely throughout Eurasia, has conducted formal research in a number of Asian countries, is fluent in Chinese and taught that language to his two children.

Dr. Garver has received numerous prestigious grants such as the Fulbright Foundation and the Chiang Ching-kuo Foundation.
