In the process of the exercise of each of our individual designs we come in contact with other people and must decide how our beliefs and values are fulfilled, utilized, compromised or realized as we are and where we are. And, ultimately, whose will do we seek - man's will or God's will - and how could that kind of definition of the importance and purpose of our lives be interpreted to help in sorting out our lives in optimistic and service oriented courses for programming the time that we have.
