Our speaker this morning was James Casart, CPA, who gave us a look at the new tax law. The law will go into effect in 1987, and virtually affects all taxes. Some of the changes include: reduction from 14 tax brackets to 2

- -no income averaging
- -no tax exempt IRA's for those with other pension plans
- -Tax shelters have been dramatically changed
- -Depreciation amounts have been re-structured

Apparently, this law was to be called the "Simplified" version, but was not due to the Truth in Advertising Act.
