



Thank you for the opportunity to serve as the North Central Governor for 2022-2023. It was an experience to always cherish. Many more great years for all of us.






President Elect Becky Kerr talked about the upcoming events at the Fine Arts Theater.



Jim Schuh talked to the Members about the upcoming Concert Jelly Roll on September 5th in the Summit Arena.




Secretary Rhonda Reuwsatt talked to the Members about the Picnic on August 20, 2023. She will be sending an Email about what Members need to bring.




Steve Ferley was the Lucky Mr. X for the day. He won \$5.00 Dollars and gave it back to the Club.


