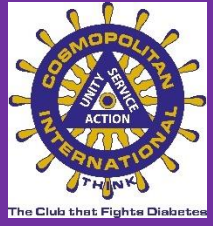

Christy Cline was our speaker today and she shared her experience in working with the JDRF One Walk this past April. The Walk had eighteen teams participating with between 200 and 300 participants. The walk took place at General Beadle Elementary school and involved the walkers going around the block at the school. According to the website, over \$24,000 was raised.

Christy has a nine-year old son who was diagnosed with T1 at the age of four. He presently uses an insulin pump.
