President Elect Becky Kerr Called the Meeting to order at 12:00 PM.




President Elect Becky Kerr Led the Members in Pledge of Allegiance


The organization also partners with a few groups on international charitable events including Special Olympics, the Global Wheelchair Mission and Habitat for Humanity.








International President Dick Groton
