




Rodney Gunn talked to the Members about the upcoming Rush Hockey game on January 10th & 13th.th.



Pay-What-You-Can



South Dakota Community Foundation Grant to Fork Real

Fork Real Community Café, Inc. – \$100,000

Fork Real Café was established in 2017 to address hunger and food insecurity in Rapid City. The café's mission is to build community through food and conversation and operates on a Pay-What-You-Can model. With BIG Funding, Fork Real Community Café's idea is to help reduce food insecurity in the Rapid City area by expanding their restaurant model to a food truck, in which the food truck also helps build skills amongst individuals who would want to work in the restaurant industry. In expanding to a food truck, Fork Real hopes to reach families and individuals who are not able to travel to the café, with transportation being a barrier.






















Dan Miller was the Lucky Mr X for the Day. He Won \$5.00 Dollars and gave it back to the Club.








Jim Blackwell was the lucky 50-50 Winner. He won \$9.00 Dollars and gave it back to the Club.


