

President Chuck Reuwsatt talked to the Members about the upcoming Federation Meeting in Sioux Fall, SD this weekend.




John Duffield Introduced their friends Alan and Barbara Varner from Anaconda Montana.

Erin Bachi from Diabetics Inc talked to the Members about the upcoming Kids Kamp and them working at the Farmers Market.




President Chuck Reuwsatt told the Members about the Spirit of Volunteerism Awards Breakfast put on by the HelpLine Center of the Black Hills.

Why Kids Deserve Dads?


- 24 Million kids growing up in a house without a father.

 - 85% of youths in prison
 - · 71% of high school dropouts
 - 63% of youth suicides
 - 90% of youth runaways and homeless
 - · 71% of teenage pregnancies

- Help go through the difficulty of divorce and come out stronger and more intentional.























Kathy Miller was the Lucky Ms. X for the day. She won \$5.00 Dollar's and gave it back to the Club.

May 8. 2023. The speaker is Kehala Two Bulls - Executive Director of the Seventh Circuit CASA Program.

The Seventh Circuit CASA Program began in 1986, making it the first CASA Program in the state of South Dakota. In 1988 we assigned our first volunteer advocate to an abused and neglected case. In the past 30 years, we have advocated for more than 1,300 abused and neglected children. With more and more children in need of advocacy services every year, we continue to strive to find ways to recruit, train, and supervise additional volunteers to reach our goal of advocating for every child. Currently there are more than 350 children waiting for their Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) Volunteer.
