

About Diabetes

Diabetes is a group of diseases marked by high levels of blood glucose resulting from defects in insulin production, insulin action, or both. Diabetes can lead to serious complications and premature death, but people with diabetes can take steps to control the disease and lower the risk of complications.

- 25.8 million Americans have diabetes or 8.3 percent of the U.S. population. –
- Of these, 7 million do not know they have the disease.
- 1.9 million people ages 20 or older are newly diagnosed with diabetes each year
- 79 million Americans have pre-diabetes
- As many as 1 in 3 Americans will have diabetes by 2050 if present trends continue
- Annual cost of diabetes in US is \$245 billion
