



Lake Arrowhead PolaRotary Bear Plunge

Rules: 1. No Wet Suits 2. No Nudity 3. Complete submersion (no time limit)

The PolaRotary Bear Plunge provides you with a venue to support your favorite charity.

Styled after fundraising “walk-a-thons”, participants solicit contributions from those who wish to support the “jumper’s” charity of choice and heroic plunge into the freezing cold waters of Lake Arrowhead. The charity must be identified, along with its 501c3 number prior to participating in the jump. Names, addresses and email addresses must also be submitted. If jumping as a team identify the team name and captain. Jumpers must all be 18 years of age or older.

The first \$1000 you raise will be split 50/50 with Rotary; anything over \$1000 will go to the charity of your choice. If you are part of a “team” jumping for the same charity, the team will be considered the same as an individual in respect to distribution of donations, although teams are limited to eight members. If your organization has more than eight who wish to participate you can have multiple teams with each team being subject to the 50/50 split. **Please keep in mind that this is a fund raiser and each individual jumper should raise at least a minimum of \$50.**

Checks are to be made out to [Lake Arrowhead Rotary Foundation](#). Please write the organization being supported and the jumpers name on the memo line. After the event, a check reflecting the “split” will then be presented to your organization. Jumpers are encouraged to collect the cash and checks pledged and bring them to the event where such funds can be turned in as part of the Check-In process. Checks collected after the event should be mailed to Lake Arrowhead Rotary, PO Box 686, Lake Arrowhead, Ca 92352. **NOTE: Jumpers are responsible for collecting all funds from sponsors.**

The format will be essentially the same with jumpers going in waves to the cheers of their supporters. Prizes will be awarded for the best costumes. **Those of you who wish to be contestants for best costume must have pictures taken, downstairs in the Evergreen Room, No Later Than 10:15am!** Registration begins at 9:00AM. Please allow yourselves time. **The Lake Arrowhead Resort & Spa** again has generously agreed to provide a changing room, hot tub and showers for the jumpers

Thank you so much for your past and future participation and we look forward to seeing you on February 2nd. **Please respect your fellow participants, spectators and the resort facilities and acknowledge their much-appreciated support.**
