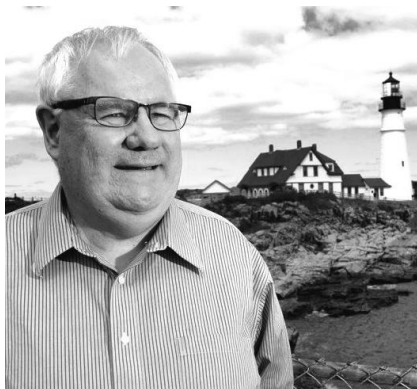


MD-PETS Speaker / Facilitator Chair, RI PolioPlus Committee *PRIVP Michael McGovern*



Mike McGovern joined Rotary in 1986 as a member of the Rotary Club of South Portland-Cape Elizabeth, Maine, USA. He has served as club president, district governor, district foundation chair, Rotarian Action Group chair, international

training leader, RI committee member and chair, trustee and vice chair of the Rotary Foundation, as well as director and vice president of Rotary International. He has served in numerous other positions at the district, zone and international levels and has attended five councils on legislation in various roles. Mike has spoken at Rotary events in 36 USA states, 8 Canadian provinces, and 34 countries.

In June 2016, Mike completed a four-year term as a trustee of the Rotary Foundation. He currently serves as chair of the International PolioPlus Committee, represents Rotary on the Polio Oversight Board of the Global Polio Eradication Initiative and is chair of the Rotary International Nominating Committee for President. He is also chairing his Rotary district by-laws committee.

Mike worked his entire career with the Town of Cape Elizabeth, Maine beginning as an intern in 1977 and serving as town manager from 1985 to 2016. He serves on the board of a not-for-profit retirement community and as chair of a committee of the diocese of his church.

He is a Major Donor to the Rotary Foundation and a recipient of the Rotary Foundation's Citation for Meritorious Service and Distinguished Service Award.
