### **GRANT APPLICATION OVERVIEW**

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of the Foundation is to assist non-profit organizations that (1) assist needy persons, particularly young people; (2) assist youth in attaining vocational excellence; (3) aid handicapped persons in regaining happy, useful lives; (4) engage in any lawful act or charitable activity for which Corporations may be organized under the Georgia Non-Profit Corporation Code.

#### **Criteria in Evaluating Grant Applications**

The Board of Directors of the Foundation is entrusted by the membership of the Kiwanis Club of Cumming and donors to the Foundation to make sound granting decisions and base those decisions on the following criteria:

- (A) Need
- (B) Attempts at locating other funding sources
- (C) Individual or corporate involvement in solution process whenever possible
- (D) Availability of limited funds
- (E) Non-Profit organizations that are located in Cumming & Forsyth County, Georgia.
- (F) Grant amounts awarded will generally not exceed \$2,500.00
- (G) Grant recipients will be required to submit a status report within 30 days after receiving the grant and every 60 days thereafter until completion of the project.
- (H) All grant monies shall be spent on recipients / services provided to residents of Forsyth County, Georgia.

Applicants may only apply for a grant once each calendar year. Applications are reviewed and grants awarded annually. Emergency applications will be reviewed as the need arises.
