



PLENARY SESSION I

Jerrie Ueberle, CEO, Global Interactions, Inc. Honorary Rotarian, Sharpstown RC, D5890

Jerrie Ueberle founded the World Academy for the Future of Women to promote and accelerate women's leadership worldwide. The program has expanded from a one-year Academy for 100 women each year, to a second year Advanced

Academy and a third year Academy in Action. In addition, a Men's Academy for the Future of Women was begun to promote collaborative work that prepares men to understand and act on issues related to advancing and promoting women in society and the workplace. The Academy gained recognition from the United Nations as a charter ASPIRE member in 2013.

Jerrie founded the Annual Women's Symposium that has attracted international speakers each May over the past 17 years. The symposium has grown to reach 10,000 participants, including university students and their mothers. The World Academy has programs in 7 countries including China, Nepal, Bangladesh, India, Mexico, Kenya, and Uganda. Jerrie's commitment is to women's equality and the achievement of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals.



PLENARY SESSION II
Salvador Rizzo Tavares, RI Director,
Zones 25A/25B/29
RC of Monterrey Carlos Canseco

Salvador Rizzo Tavares joined Rotary in 1989 at the age of 27. He is an active member of the Rotary Club of Monterrey Carlos Canseco, served twice as club president, District Governor of District 4130, and Rotary Coordinator, Zone 25A.

He has led 5 global grants addressing issues related to eating disorders, and environmental matters, and providing equipment to hospitals and public schools.

In his Rotary life, Salvador has primarily focused on three aspects: connecting Rotarians across clubs, cities, and countries; actively engaging young professionals in Rotary beyond their local club through workshops and forums in several Latin American countries; and providing training to enhance understanding of Rotary. To do that, he was the founder of the Rotary Leadership Institute (RLI) in 11 countries, leading it for 10 years. Salvador served as a Training Leader at the International Assembly in 2020 and 2021. He served as a member of the World Committee for New Generations in 2014-1015.



PLENARY SESSION III Jim Halderman, Rotary Peace Activator

Golden RC, Past District Governor, D5450

Jim Halderman has been a Rotarian since 1991 and serves as the Ombudsman for District 5450, where he served as District Governor in 2011-2012. Zones 26/27 list him in their Expert Hub for conflict resolution.

He has taught court-ordered, company-ordered, and spousal-ordered, clients for 28 years in anger and conflict management. He is certified with the National Curriculum Training Institute, the leader in the field of Cognitive Behavioral Change Programs and has facilitated Alternative to Violence Programs in prisons, teaching anger management and life skills.

Jim was one of 27 in the United States and Canada to be trained in Rotary International's peace endeavor and the Institute for Economics and Peace. A recipient of Rotary International's Service Above Self Award in 2020, his passion is to work with Rotarian's effort to bring peace to all.



PLENARY SESSION IV

Mário César Martins de Camargo, RI President-Elect Santo Andre RC, D4521

Mário César Martins de Camargo joined Rotary in 1980 at the age of 23. A past director and trustee, de Camargo will be the fourth Brazilian to serve as president of RI.

He has served in international roles including RI learning facilitator, Zone Coordinator for the Avoidable Blindness Taskforce, Latin American Coordinator for the Health Problems Taskforce, RI president's representative, and delegate to the Council on legislation. Additionally, he served on the RI Membership Development Committee, The Rotary Foundation Programs Finance Committee, and the International PolioPlus Committee.

In addition to leading numerous professional associations, including the Brazilian Association of Printing Technology (ABTG) and the Brazilian Printing Industry Association (ABIGRAF), Mário used the 2020 COVID lockdown to study for and pass the bar exam – 38 years after attending law school – and learning Italian.

Mário says Rotary global reach never ceases to impress him and that "With Service Above Self, Rotary has created a unique global identity that is unlike any other I know."




