New Member Procedures

Any person of legal age, good moral character and good reputation in their community may be granted membership in this Lions club. NOTE: It is the policy of the Conroe Noon Lions Club to NOT extend an invitation of membership to any candidate for public office or to any individual who intends to announce his candidacy for public office in the near future until after such election.

PROCEDURES

- 1 The sponsoring Lion is to turn in a complete MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION form to the membership committee. Please, DO NOT collect the initiation fee at this time.
- 2 The membership committee will review the application and will contact the proposed member for a personal interview. The committee may also speak to the sponsoring Lion concerning the proposed member's sincerity and commitment with regards to Lionism.
- **3** The membership committee will give a recommendation to the Board of Directors at their next meeting. If the Board of Directors approves the MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION, the club office will notify the prospect of their approval and collect the initiation fee of \$130.00 (\$75.00 for initiation and \$55.00 for first month's dues). The new member will accept the INVITATION OF MEMBERSHIP with a signed form and a new membership packet. In the event the Board of Directors does not approve the proposed member, the sponsoring Lion will be notified.
- It is only after the prospective member has paid their fees and signed all forms that they may be referred to as a NEW MEMBER.
- 5 It is the responsibility of the sponsoring Lion to involve and introduce the new Lion to the activities and policies of the Conroe Noon Lions Club and those of Lions International.
- 6 It is also the recommendation of the Board of Directors that the new Lion complete the Blue Badge Exchange card during the new Lion's first six months.
