### Topic "Edmonton Lifelong Learners Association"

After more than 40 years in leadership roles in Seniors Health and Continuing Care, Lynne s (mostly) retired from Alberta Health Services and lives in Edmonton. She is the current President of the Edmonton Lifelong Learners Association (ELLA.) ELLA is a voluntary, non-profit society that proudly offers on-line and in-person courses every year to enrich the live of adults 50+. In addition she is President of the Alberta Association of Gerontology (AAG) a provincial interdisciplinary association that advocates for quality of life for older adults and their families. Lynne loves to travel, golf and spend time with her three grandchildren.

A charitable organization since 2002, ELLA offered in person classes at the University of Alberta campus during the month of May. In 2020 the pandemic forced a pivot to online classes, which have proved extremely popular with members. And why not. They're convenient (share the space with your cat, view classes during your tropical vacation); comfortable (wear your pyjamas, leave the dirty dishes on the counter); and safe (the weather forecast doesn't matter). Over 500 participants have joined each online session ELLA has hosted. Going forward, ELLA plans to continue one session of online learning and one in person session.
