1. Speaker - for November 16 2022

Professor Robert Smith

Topic "D-Day & Men of Edmonton"

Robert Smith is a Professor of History at the University of Alberta. He was awarded the Faculty of Arts Award for Research Excellence in 2016 and for Undergraduate Teaching in 2020. He was a Fellow of the National Humanities Center in 1995 and the Lindbergh Chair of Aerospace History at the Smithsonian Institution's National Air and Space Museum in 2007. One of the courses he teaches at the University of Alberta is on the History of World War II, and he has particular interests in rocketry and codebreaking in the War.

June 6th, 1944, D-Day, saw around 150,000 Allied troops land in Normandy supported by many thousands of aircraft and ships. D-Day was in fact the largest amphibious invasion in history, and in his talk, Robert Smith will examine D-Day's planning, D-Day itself and its immediate aftermath, as well as why it mattered in the overall context of the War. In so doing, he will discuss some Edmontonians who were involved in the events of that remarkable day.
