Shreela Chakrabartty

Topic

"The Punjabi Pioneer"



Shreela Chakrabartty, is an Edmonton born Canadian to immigrant parents, originating from an undivided India between the mid 1920s to the early 60s when they settled in Edmonton. After working on an Oscar nominated movie in 2004, Shreela traveled extensively around India to learn about her heritage. As a Shastri Indo Canadian Fellowship scholar, she conducted research for her documentary project Bengali Bungalow at the Satyajit Ray Film and Television Institute in Kolkata. Returning to Edmonton, she visited the Provincial Archives of Alberta to see about preserving an original copy of her family tree. It was there that she learned that there isn't much documentation of people from India. Since 2015, she has been on a mission to inform South Asian communities about their absence from private records in Alberta. In 2014, she made her international feature film directorial debut in the Shreela & Kash thriller, Rock Paper Dice Enter followed by the drama. Lake Shore Drive. She is the Director of Punjabi Pioneers of Alberta, as part of a team sponsored by the Telus Storyhive documentary program. Recently, she's been documenting life around Chicago, Illinois, from a motorcycle on the YouTube Channel, #RidingWithKash.
