

## 1. Speaker - for January 18 2022 Dr. Allan A. Offenberger

### **Topic** "The Future of Fusion Energy"

Fusion of nuclei, the source of energy in our sun and stars, can provide the clean, sustainable base load energy required to power our future in electricity, heat and hydrogen for stationary and mobile applications. Harnessing fusion on earth requires heating fuel to ~100 million degrees and confining it (a difficult task) for sufficient time to realize energy gain. Progress in fusion science has moved to an engineering phase to demonstrate net energy production. There are a variety of technological approaches being pursued in academic, government and industry labs that offer promise; success will transform energy policy worldwide. This talk will highlight status, approaches & possible timelines for fusion energy demonstration. Recent success in achieving "ignition" will stimulate industrial development of enabling technologies to speed fusion energy development. Possible demonstration systems are likely to emerge in the 2030's but penetration as a major energy source will take decades.



Allan Offenberger is Professor Emeritus of Electrical & Computer Engineering (Engineering Physics) at the University of Alberta. He received his B.A.Sc. and M.A.Sc. degrees from the University of British Columbia (UBC - Engineering Physics 1962, Physics 1963) and Ph.D. degree from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT - Nuclear Sciences & Engineering 1968).

His research program for more than 40 years was focused on the development of high power lasers and their application to plasma physics and inertial fusion energy research. His research group pioneered areas in laser development, laser/plasma interaction physics and optical instrument innovations (especially Thomson scattering).

Allan was the Founding President of the Fusion Energy Council of Canada. Among other activities, he served as a Founding Board Member of the Ontario Laser Lightwave & Research Centre and as an Editorial Board Member of Laser & Particle Beams (Cambridge University Press).
