She began as a volunteer teacher during her university years and has since held various significant roles within both national and local Ismaili Council institutions.

Professionally, Nilam has held various senior positions in the Government of Alberta and is currently the Assistant Deputy Minister for Arts, Culture and Status of Women. She collaborates with ministry partners, other levels of government, and community stakeholders to develop and promote strategic polices aimed at increasing gender equality. Additionally, she supports community organizations, the non-profit sector, and the voluntary sector to help build vibrant and resilient communities through various programs and grants. Furthermore, she works to enhance the enjoyment and viability of the arts and cultural industries in Alberta.

In 2022, Nilam received the Queen Elizabeth II Platinum Jubilee Medal in recognition of her service to Albertans.

In 2024, Nilam received the King Charles Coronation Medal in recognition for her voluntary service in the community.

Did you know Canada has the oldest rocks?

The exposed portions of continental crust known as the Canadian Shield comprise about half of Canada's land mass, taking up most of Québec and Ontario, large swathes of the Northern territories, pieces of the prairie provinces and most of Greenland. Covering such a large area, it contains important insight



into the planet's geological history. Within this geologic shield, the Acasta Gneiss Complex – found about 300 km north of Yellowknife, NWT – is believed to be over four billion years old; the oldest terrestrial rock material ever discovered on Earth.
