Topic: January SEATECT Meeting – Guest Speaker Mackenzie Nance, Mekong Club.

The Job Verification Tool is a survey-based platform designed to help recent graduates and job seekers assess the legitimacy of job offers and advertisements. Translated into more than 10 languages, it aims to reduce the risk of individuals being deceived by fraudulent recruitment schemes, particularly those that may lead to trafficking for forced criminality.

Through a user-friendly interface (i.e., a web form or mobile-accessible survey), job seekers will answer a series of 20 multiple-choice questions about a job they are considering. Based on their responses, the tool will generate a composite risk-score, categorizing the opportunity as Low, Medium, or High Risk, and offer corresponding guidance (i.e., "*Seek more information,*" "*Proceed with caution,*" or "*Do not pursue and report as a scam*").

Designed as a preventative and accessible resource, the tool can be widely distributed by universities, NGOs, and online employment platforms, helping job seekers make safer, more informed decisions.
