Prevention of Child Abuse

Prevention of child abuse became Exchange's National Project in 1979. To uphold its National Project, Exchange provides a variety of public awareness materials designed to help inform and increase awareness of child abuse and how it can be prevented. In 2016, the Isle of Palms Exchange Club exclusively took over the planning, organization, operations, marketing, and sponsorship of the Isle of Palms Connector Run and Walk for the Child raising over \$1.3M and donating it to agencies in the Lowcountry working towards the prevention of child abuse.
