SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS

Please read the following thirteen conditions. By signing this form, you agree to the scholarship conditions and to allow a request to be made of Farmington High School, St. Paul Lutheran High School or Mineral Area College to verify your class rank and/or GPA. Please note the signature of a parent/guardian is required.

1. ELIGIBLE RECIPIENTS

- A. <u>First-time applicant</u> is any current senior at Farmington High School or St Paul Lutheran High School, (hereinafter "HS"), who meets eligibility requirements at Mineral Area College, (hereinafter "MAC"), during the fall semester immediately following his/her HS graduation.
- B. <u>Recipient applying to renew</u> is a current recipient of *The Mark Griggs Memorial Farmington Kiwanis Scholarship* who wishes to re-apply for the scholarship, so long as all attendance, academic performance and other requirements set forth in the Academic Eligibility Criteria section have and continue to be met. It is the responsibility of the current scholarship recipient to re-apply for the sophomore year.

2. ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- A. Maintain a minimum of a 2.5 cumulative GPA for HS and MAC coursework.
- B. Maintain full-time student status of registering for, and completing, a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours per semester.
- C. Graduating seniors shall attend the spring High School Awards Ceremony to accept the scholarship, but for good cause, may be excused by a Farmington Kiwanis Club official. To be excused, contact Mandi Farrell at (573) 366-8301 at least seven days prior to the ceremony date.

3. <u>SCHOLARSHIP TERM</u>

The initial scholarship is for the fall and spring semesters of the freshman year. The summer semester is not included. The scholarship may be renewed for the sophomore year upon submission of a proper application and continued compliance with the Academic Eligibility Criteria requirements set forth above.

4. SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT FOR 2023-2024

The amount of the scholarship will be \$ 750.00 (seven hundred fifty dollars) for the Fall 2024 semester and \$750.00 (seven hundred fifty dollars) for the Spring 2025 semester at Mineral Area College.

5. ELIGIBLE EXPENSES & UNUSED FUNDS

Scholarship funds may be used for tuition, books, and fees. Unused funds shall not be carried over to the next semester or academic year.

6. SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENT

The scholarship is paid directly to Mineral Area College. No funds shall be awarded directly to the recipient nor his/her family.

7. FORFEITURE OF SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient shall forfeit any remaining benefit of this scholarship if he/she:

- fails to attend the spring 2024 High School Awards Ceremony to accept the scholarship or meet all requirements in the Academic Eligibility Criteria section,
 - or, otherwise withdraws from classes or fails to enroll, attend, or complete the Fall 2024 semester's coursework.

8. SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

- B. Applications are also available in the High School counselors' offices in early February.
- C. Applications are due no later than April 15, 2024. Completed applications and accompanying materials should be mailed to Farmington Kiwanis, C/O Mandi Farrell, 520 Maple Street, Farmington, MO 63640 and postmarked no later than April 10, 2024. - D. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

9. ONE-PAGE TYPEWRITTEN ESSAY

Applicants should prepare a one-page typewritten essay outlining his/her educational and career goals.

10. CONTACT INFORMATION

Applicants shall provide a working telephone number, email address, mailing address as well as information for an alternate contact person.

11. PUBLICITY

Recipients shall attend at least one Kiwanis meeting during the term of the scholarship, agree to photographs, and provide information for media coverage.
